Goal

Humanize and support the Nigerian Police Force



Justification

- Many Nigerian police officers come from **humble beginnings** and **challenging neighborhoods**
- **Despite limited opportunities**, they chose **service over crime**, dedicating their lives to protecting others
- Their **resilience** and **commitment reflect the noble seed** within them, **deserving recognition and support**
